As part of your sanction for violating the campus alcohol policy, you have been asked to complete AlcoholEdu® for Sanctions. This online, science-based course is designed to teach you about the effects of alcohol on the body and mind, and to assist you in making safer and healthier decisions so you can avoid trouble in the future.

**PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY:**

You are expected to complete **AlcoholEdu for Sanctions** You will need **one EverFi Higher Education Account** to access the course(s) from your dashboard.

**\*If you already have an EverFi Higher Ed Account**, go to <http://www.everfi.com/login>, enter your login information, then enter registration code **b6e59e78** in the "Add a Course" box in the top right corner of the Dashboard.

**If you do NOT already have an EverFi Higher Ed Account:**

- Go to: <http://www.everfi.com/login>
- Enter the Registration Code: **b6e59e78** and click **"I'm a Student"** to create your EverFi Account
  - Note: When prompted, please enter your Student ID Number to receive credit for completion. You can look-up your Student ID on MyMack.
- Complete Part 1 of AlcoholEdu for Sanctions by the assigned date in your hearing resolution letter with a passing score of 75%.
- After 30-45 days you will receive an invitation to complete Part 2 of AlcoholEdu for Sanctions.

**Other Important Information:**

- You will need Internet access and audio capabilities.
- To avoid technical issues, please use any major web browser (e.g., Firefox, Internet Explorer, Google Chrome) released within the previous two years.
- You may take the course in multiple sittings.
- The course may include surveys to help personalize your experience and measure students' attitudes and behaviors. All survey responses are confidential; the school will only receive information about the student body as a whole and will never see individual students' answers.
- Should you experience problems, technical support is available 24/7 and can be accessed from the "Help" link within the course.
