



**ACT Lawrence** is a non-profit community development corporation (CDC) providing housing counseling and financial coaching services for low to moderate income populations. (*Lawrence, MA*)

**Fellowship Activities:** (1) Conduct marketing and communication efforts to engage clients, volunteers and funders; (2) Recruit, train and coordinate volunteers; (3) Research funding opportunities and assist in grant writing.



**Beverly Council on Aging** provides services including transportation, advocacy, education, health, and recreation to support well-being and independence for Beverly seniors and their families. (*Beverly, MA*)
