



**Allston Brighton Community Development Corporation** is a non-profit community development corporation that oversees a portfolio of affordable housing units in nine sites throughout Allston Brighton. (*Allston, MA*)

**Fellowship Activities:** (1) Connect residents with community partnerships and neighborhood stabilization initiatives; (2) Conduct advocacy work for affordable housing, transportation and community development.



**ACT Lawrence**, a Latina-led non-profit Community Development Corporation, and the **Merrimack College Financial Capability Center** collaborate to increase financial literacy to residents in Lawrence. (Lawrence/North Andover, MA)

**Fellowship Activities:** (1) Coordinates educational and coaching programs; (2) Conducts marketing, communication and grant writing (3) Develop and implement outreach strategies; (3) Develop tracking and reporting systems.
