New Feature for All Users

The new Video Everywhere capability allows you to record, embed AND reuse video all throughout a course. This feature can be accessed through the content editor – so anywhere you add content within a course, you can add video.

Create Blog Entry

Blog Entries make up the content of a Blog. Depending on the Blog settings, Entries may be edited or deleted by their authors. Blog Entries can be saved as a draft to edit or delete at a later time. [More Help](#)

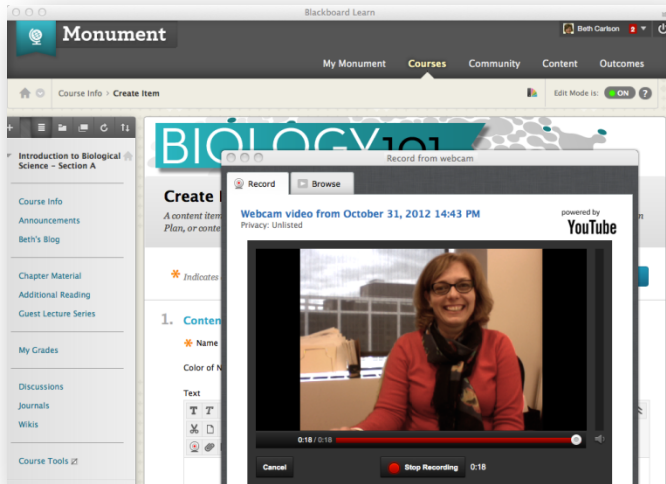
