## Warriors Athletics Winter Season Concludes

It was an outstanding weekend for Warriors track star Carly Muscaro. The senior captain of the **No. 15 women's track & field team** successfully defended her National Championship in the 400M with the fastest time in Division II history and, less than an hour later, ran to her second National Championship of the weekend, this time in the 200M. Muscaro also ran as part of the women's 4X400 team which finished in fourth place, earning All-American status for the second consecutive year.



The eighth-seeded Merrimack **men's basketball team** season saw its outstanding season come to an end on Sunday evening with a 73-70 loss in the semifinals of the Division II Northeast Regional. The Warriors advanced to the semifinals by way of a 72-68 overtime upset of top-seeded LeMoyne on Saturday evening. Merrimack ends the season at 19-12, the most wins recorded since the 2009-2010 season. The Warriors were guided by first-year Head Coach Joe Gallo '04 and Assistant Coach Micky Burtnyk '08.
