Melissa Siegel Joins the Office of the Provost Team

The Provost Office welcomes Melissa Siegel, Director of Sponsored Programs, to the team. Melissa joined Merrimack College in October, 2016 reporting to the Office for Development and Alumni Affairs (ODAR). Since her arrival, she has been part of a team with Kathy Redmond, Director of Corporate and Foundation Relations, and together in FY17 they collectively submitted over \$4M in sponsored proposals. While this restructuring aligns sponsored and academic goals, given the connection between faculty scholarship and sponsored programs, the Provost Office and ODAR will continue to work together closely to help faculty apply for external funding. Melissa will assist with finding federal funding opportunities, proposal submissions, compliance oversight, policy and procedure development and dissemination, and post-award grant management support.

STEM Center Proposal for School of Science and Engineering

Madhu Dhar, Ph.D., M.Ed., has served at Merrimack College as an adjunct faculty in Physics and Astronomy since 2008. Her passion for STEM students' success and retention influenced her to pursue her Masters in Higher Education at Merrimack College. During her masters fellowship as the STEM Academic Advisor, Dr. Dhar conducted an extensive research project on the shrinking STEM pipeline in higher education. Her Capstone project proposes a STEM Center that provides infrastructural support for undergraduate students in the School of Science and Engineering at Merrimack College. The proposed STEM Center will consolidate programs under a single entity and create a continuum of resources designed to support students at every stage of their education.

With low numbers of students enrolling in STEM fields and even smaller numbers of women and minorities in the STEM pipeline, colleges and universities need to pay particular-attention to

retaining the students they have. Women in STEM initiatives at Merrimack College were championed by Dr. Dhar and helped launch our very first Women in STEM–LLC http://www.merrimack.edu/live/news/4066-new-residential-community-supports-women-in-stem

The Capstone includes a detailed theoretical framework, organizational infrastructure and complete analysis of STEM enrollment and retention data and trends and is available for reference in Merrimack Scholar works.
