Dr. Kathryn Nielsen takes on new administrative role in the Office of the Provost

It is a pleasure to announce the appointment of Dr. Kathryn Nielsen as Associate Provost and Director of Strategic Initiatives. In her new administrative role, Dr. Nielsen will continue leading the Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning (CETL) and will further direct projects related to Mobile Merrimack, the College's Apple and iPad program. She will also provide stewardship and support for administrative and faculty development and provide oversight on several recent grants and awards. A member of the Merrimack community since 2001, Dr. Nielsen holds a Ph.D. in Education from Lesley University, an M.A. in Literature from the University of New Hampshire, and a B.A. in English from Merrimack College where she graduated summa cum laude and was the recipient of the Bishop Markham Medal for the highest ranking student in the humanities. She has taught undergraduate and graduate courses, and has served the Merrimack College community in numerous administrative roles, most recently as the founding director of the CETL. As an active scholar in the field of higher education, she has been published in New Directions in Transformative Learning and the Journal of the Academy of Business Education and in book chapters that focus on inclusive teaching and learning. Dr. Nielsen is a graduate of the HERS Wellesley Leadership Institute and most recently completed the Harvard Management Development Program in Cambridge. She serves on the Board of Directors of the Haverhill Girls and Boys Club.
