## Senior Week 2019 Policies

- The Senior Week Wristband is your ticket to fun for the week. Wristbands will be available Tuesday, May 14th beginning at 2:00pm in the 1st Floor Lounge of the Sakowich Campus Center, to seniors who have completed their Senior Week Package purchase by the deadline. There will be no day of sales.
- Government Issued Photo-ID and Merrimack College ID is required for all events involving alcohol. Your wristband does not confirm your age for any event.
- Safety is important. All events taking place off campus will have bus transportation. In order to participate you must take the bus, no exceptions.
- Bags and coolers are subject to search on campus.
- This is a celebration of Seniors, therefore no guests are allowed on campus. Merrimack College undergraduate, graduate, or otherwise are NOT permitted on campus for the week or at on/off campus Senior Week Events.
- No food or beverage of any kind is permitted on any transportation provided for Senior Week. Bags will be checked before you enter the buses.
- All campus policies found in the Student Code of Conduct & Student Handbook remain in effect for Senior Week. Quiet hours begin at 1:00am and end at 8:00am.
- Any violations of the Student Code of Conduct and Student Handbook, and/or Senior Week policies will be adjudicated in 24-48 hours of the incident. Responsible findings may result in fines, hold on your student account, suspension from Senior Week activities or not being able to participate in Commencement.

### **PERSONAL LIMIT**

- *For Personal Limit:* The maximum amount of alcohol permitted in the possession of someone who is of legal age must not exceed the equivalent of: 18 twelve ounce beers or the equivalent in other containers; OR, one pint of liquor; OR, one half gallon of wine.

## **Senior Week CHECK-OUT**

Please pay attention to the following check-out procedures depending upon where you currently live.

After Commencement, all seniors will need to be checked out of their space, or complete an express checkout before 6:00 pm.

### **Where to check out:**

Seniors living in St. Thomas/St. Ann Apartments and Monican will check out in the St. Thomas Community Center.

Seniors living in O'Brien, the Townhouses, North, South, Deegan or Ash will check out in the community space 508 in South Residential Village (House 5).

Seniors in Royal Crest will check-out at the Royal Crest Clubhouse.

### **For seniors who have purchased the Senior Week package:**

- All rooms will be inspected at the conclusion of Senior Week to note any changes or damages.
- At the end of Senior Week your room should be restored to move-in condition as you found it in August.
- All seniors remaining on campus for Senior Week must be checked out of their rooms by 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 19, 2019. We suggest you start moving your belongings out the week before Commencement to save time on Commencement.
