Senior Week 2019 FAQ

1. Can I stay on campus during Senior Week?

Yes. All students participating in the Senior Week package or a la carte options are permitted to stay on campus in their current Residence Hall from Friday, May 10th - Sunday, May 19th. All students must be moved and checked out of their Residence Hall by 6:00 pm on Sunday, May 19th, 2019.

2. I'm a commuter student, can I stay on campus during Senior Week?

Yes. We encourage all commuter students who are participating in Senior Week to stay with friends on campus. If you do not have a place to stay, please contact the Office of Residence Life at reslife@merrimack.edu or 978-837-5507.

3. Is transportation provided to and from the Senior Week events?

Yes. Transportation is provided and REQUIRED for all Senior Week events with the exception of Commencement Ball. Details regarding bus pick-up, drop-off times and locations will be communicated closer to the events.

4. Are there additional costs during Senior Week?

Yes. Food is provided at all of the Senior Week events. However, please plan accordingly if you would like to have meals/snacks in your room. All of the events have a cash bar, so if you are 21+ and wish to purchase alcohol, you will need cash or a credit card in addition to your government issued ID.

5. Can I get a refund on Senior Week?

No. We do not process refunds for Senior Week. If you have work or an internship conflict, we will work with you on a case-by-case basis.

6. Can I bring a guest to the Senior Week events?

Senior Week is a time for Merrimack Seniors to celebrate their accomplishments together. Guests are not permitted on campus during this time or at any of the events with the exception of Commencement Ball.

Yes. Please bring your government issued ID and your MackCard with you to all events. If you do not have your government issued ID and plan to purchase alcohol, you will not be served.
