

IMPORTANCE OF THE PINNING

The pinning formalizes the transition from student to professional nurse. The tradition itself has roots back to the 12th century but is more typically associated with Florence Nightingale, considered the founder of modern nursing, who presented medals of excellence to exemplary nursing graduates at her London school. She captured the public imagination when she led a group of female nurses to Crimea in October of 1854 to deliver nursing service to British soldiers.

The pinning ceremony signifies that students have joined the sisterhood and brotherhood of nurses and are ready to serve society as a healthcare professional.

Nursing has often been referred to as a "calling" and the modern pinning ceremony is based on the history of this respected profession.
