YOUR MACKTASKS CHECKLIST

Make sure you are checking your @merrimack.edu email address and myMack regularly for MackTasks such as:

- Register for Orientation; choose either a single day or overnight session!
- Add Emergency Contact Info: this task takes less than 10 seconds!
- First-year students: Complete your Academic Interest Form so you can review your first semester schedule during Orientation!
- Add parents/family to your Student Account Center. Payment plans are available as early as June and bills will be posted in July.
- Complete your online health forms and upload all of your immunization information. You can also bring documents with you to Orientation.

IMPORTANT DETAILS

» HOUSING AT ORIENTATION (if staying overnight)

When arriving on campus, all students will be assigned a double room with a classmate. If you want to stay with a specific student, just check in together!

» FAMILIES AT ORIENTATION

Students can add up to 3 family members when registering for Orientation. Family members will have their own set of Orientation activities during their students' chosen session on 6/11, 6/12, 6/17 or 6/20. Family members do not stay overnight on campus. www.merrimack.edu/hotels

» PARKING AT ORIENTATION

Cars are allowed on campus for Orientation! No parking decals required.
